*Situated on the sea front with

 Lowestoft in Suffolk. The Grade 2  
 listed building was once the family  
 home of Col. Alfred Lucas, CO of  
 the 17<sup>th</sup> Suffolk Rifle Volunteers  
 and now offers first rate serviced  
 holiday accommodation to hotel  
 standards.*

The Centre was founded as a memorial to the national hero Field Marshal Lord Kitchener of Khartoum and was opened in 1919.

The Centre now offers holiday accommodation to men and women who have served in the armed forces, the merchant service and the civilian emergency services. Included are their non-service partners, widows and widowers.

The Centre is open from April to October and has ten centrally heated en-suite twin bedded rooms. Two of the en-suite rooms have been converted to have walk-in Showers. In addition each room has tea and coffee making facilities, a mini fridge and new for 2019 will be a 24" colour TV.

Fixtures, fittings and decor are maintained to a high standard. There are two TV lounges, one reading lounge and an air-conditioned dining room on the ground floor and guest bedrooms are on the first and second floors. A lift provides easy access to all floors. Tea and coffee are also available throughout the day on a self-service basis in the dining room.

A friendly and easy going atmosphere is created by the husband and wife team of a resident Manager and Cook/Housekeeper. A full English breakfast and an evening meal are provided to a high standard with a generous and varied menu.

The Centre is in a traffic calmed part of the town, on a bus route, about half a mile away from the town centre with it's railway station, bus station and principal shops. Close by in Kirkley there is a secondary shopping area.

Two four wheeled electric buggies are available for hire. Pre-booking is advisable if required and there is ramp access to the rear of the premises at basement level. An electric vehicle charging point is adjacent to the small car park at the rear. Parking should be pre-booked and is available on a first come, first served basis. There is a large public car park almost opposite the centre.
